



# คำนำ

หนังสือคู่มือชุดนี้ แต่ละเล่มประกอบด้วยข้อสอบพร้อมเฉลยอย่างละเอียด ที่ครอบคลุมเนื้อหา ทั้งหมดตามที่ สทศ.กำหนดอย่างครบถ้วน มีความยากมากกว่าข้อสอบ O-NET และอาจจะมีระดับ ความยากใกล้เคียงหรือมากกว่าข้อสอบ PAT โดยแบ่งข้อสอบออกเป็น 2 ส่วน คือ ข้อสอบส่วนที่ 1 เป็น ข้อสอบที่จำแนกออกตามเนื้อหาของแต่ละเรื่อง ซึ่งนักเรียนจะได้ฝึกทำข้อสอบในทุกเรื่องจนเกิดความเข้าใจ สร้างทักษะและความชำนาญในการทำข้อสอบได้ด้วยตนเอง และข้อสอบส่วนที่ 2 เป็นชุดข้อสอบที่มี จำนวนข้อสอบของแต่ละชุดสอดคล้องตามที่ สทศ.กำหนด และมีการเพิ่มระดับความยากมากขึ้นเรื่อย ๆ ในชุดข้อสอบถัดไปตามลำดับ ซึ่งนักเรียนจะได้ฝึกทำข้อสอบเสมือนสอบจริง เพื่อประเมินความพร้อม ของตนเองก่อนสอบจริง นอกจากนี้ นักเรียนยังได้ทบทวนเนื้อหาในคำอธิบายของคำตอบจากเฉลยของ ข้อสอบทั้ง 2 ส่วน ซึ่งเป็นการเสริมความรู้ เพิ่มพูนความเข้าใจและประสบการณ์ ทำให้นักเรียนเกิด ความมั่นใจและพร้อมที่จะนำไปประยุกต์ใช้เพื่อการสอบจริงได้อีกด้วย
